

Conditions of entry

All entries must be for sale, ready for hanging with screw eyes, wire or cord securely attached and suitably framed.

Size for paintings - no larger than 150cm x 150cm

Size for sculptures - up to 100cm x 100cm

Entry fee of \$5 per entry, not refundable. Entry limited to three per person.

Each entry to be clearly marked with the artists name, title and price (labels provided).

All entries to be securely packed with suitable packing for return consignment. All transport costs, insurance to/from the exhibition will be met by the exhibitor.

Sales commission is 20%. Sales during the last show reached \$4000 and we expect similar this time.

Every care will be exercised but the organisers shall in no way be responsible for damage, loss or theft.

The committee reserves the right to reject any particular exhibit considered unsuitable.

The decisions of the organisers on all matters shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The organisers reserve the right to have any work reproduced in the press or television.

Late entries or wet paintings will not be accepted

'Art on the Range' is a biennial exhibition and sale of contemporary and traditional fine artworks including paintings, drawings, sculpture and photography. The first exhibition was held in 1992 and since then has gone on to be the premier artshow in the region.

Each year, the exhibition and sale attracts works from recognized regional artists who work in a variety of media. The list of invited contributors is regularly reviewed for quality and variety to ensure that affordable investment pieces are available and the show is attractive to visitors from across New South Wales especially Canberra, the Illawarra, Southern Highlands, Sydney and Central West.

The show is organized by the Crookwell & District Arts Council and proceeds from the event go towards subsidizing workshops and performances that enhance the cultural life of the local community. These initiatives provide opportunities for adults and youth to advance their skills, experience and enjoyment of the visual arts.

The show derives its name from its location. Crookwell is situated on the top of the Great Dividing Range nearly 1000m above sea level. The township is easily accessible from Canberra, Sydney, South Coast and Central West locations and is establishing itself as a short stay destination of choice.

Once again 'Art on the Range' will be held in the fabulous Crookwell Memorial Centre which encompasses both the Crookwell Regional Art Gallery and the Memorial Hall offering ample space to exhibit a wide range of artworks in a relaxed and welcoming setting.
